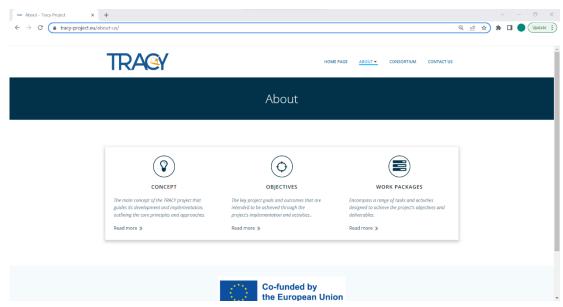

• **Home Page**: Presents a brief description of the project and outlines the main methodology to be followed.

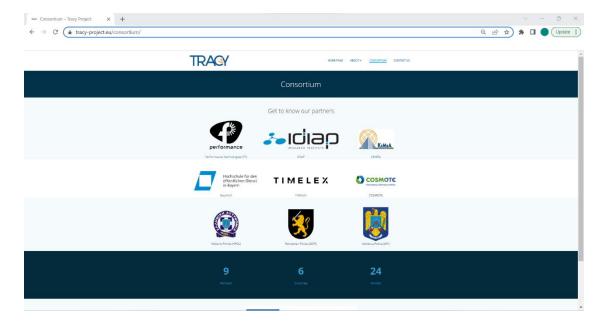


• **About**: Contains a drop-down menu that allows the user to navigate between the project concept, objectives, and work packages webpages.



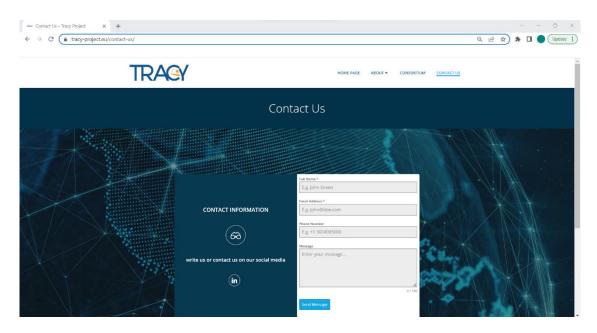


• **Consortium**: Showcases the logos of consortium partners, providing direct access to the homepage of each partner.
